
## Local initiatives

#### WASTE MANAGEMENT

Anantara Krasnapolsky is part of a narrow circle of companies in Amsterdam which opts for its waste to be collected by boat via the canals instead of using dedicated trucks.



#### PLASTIC REDUCTION

We collaborated with Earth Water to conceive 1L glass bottles for room use therefore completely eliminating the plastic ones. All profit is invested in various projects around the world for fresh drinkable water.



#### ELECTRIC CAR CHARGING STATIONS


At our parking lot, we provide our customers with 8 charging stations for their electric cars to encourage the use of low-emission vehicles and reduce the carbon emissions.

# Social responsability actions


At Anantara Grand Hotel Krasnapolsky Amsterdam, we promote diversity and inclusion not only within our team, but also among partners & suppliers.

## Social responsability activities




#### BREAKFAST AGAINST LONELINESS
